






# How do you become an Olympic Champion?

## Competition days




On each of the four competition days, a medal or a certificate will be awarded in every competition based on the total number of points attained:

-  **GOLD** = 90-100 points
-  **SILVER** = 80-89.99 points
-  **BRONZE** = 70-79.99 points
- Diploma = 60-69.99 points
- Certification of participation = up to 60 points

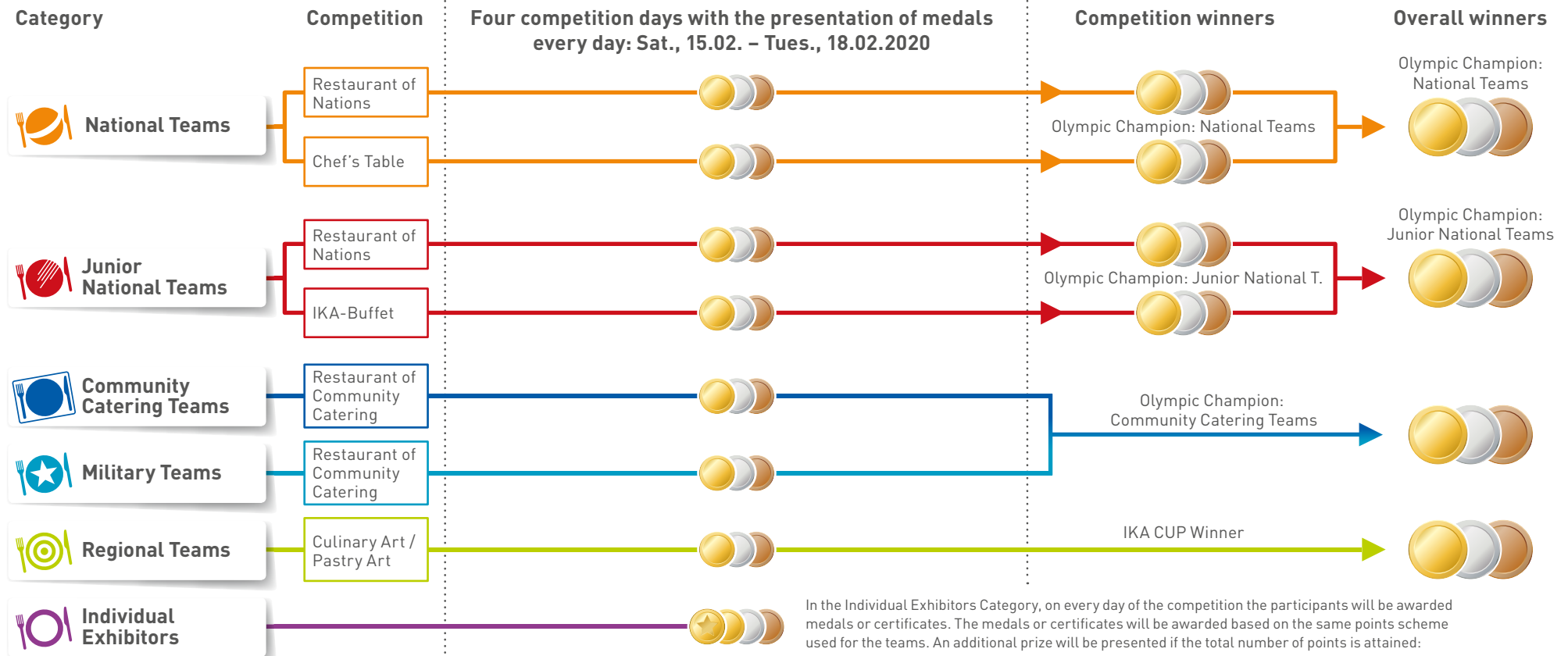
Several teams may receive the same medal here.

## Award ceremony

The winners in the individual competitions and the overall winners will be honoured during the award ceremony on **Wednesday, 19 February 2020**. The teams achieving the highest number of points on the four competition days will receive medals and can call themselves Olympic Champions:

-  **GOLD** = highest number of points
-  **SILVER** = second highest number of points
-  **BRONZE** = third highest number of points

Only one gold, silver and bronze medal will be awarded each time.



In the Individual Exhibitors Category, on every day of the competition the participants will be awarded medals or certificates. The medals or certificates will be awarded based on the same points scheme used for the teams. An additional prize will be presented if the total number of points is attained:

-  **GOLD with distinction** = 100 points
